### Administrator of Estate Seeks Damages

Morris Stone, administrator of the estate of Keith Stone, deceased, has filed suit for damages in the sum of \$1000 against Roamers Rest, Inc., for the drowning of Keith Stone, 14, on July 2nd.

Administrator in his complaint alleges that Keith while diving into the river from a spring board was caught and entangled upon a snag beneath the surface of the water and was not able to extricate himself and was drowned; alleges the defendants negligent in allowing the snags and branches to accumulate in the water which constituted grave damages and hazards to patrons.
