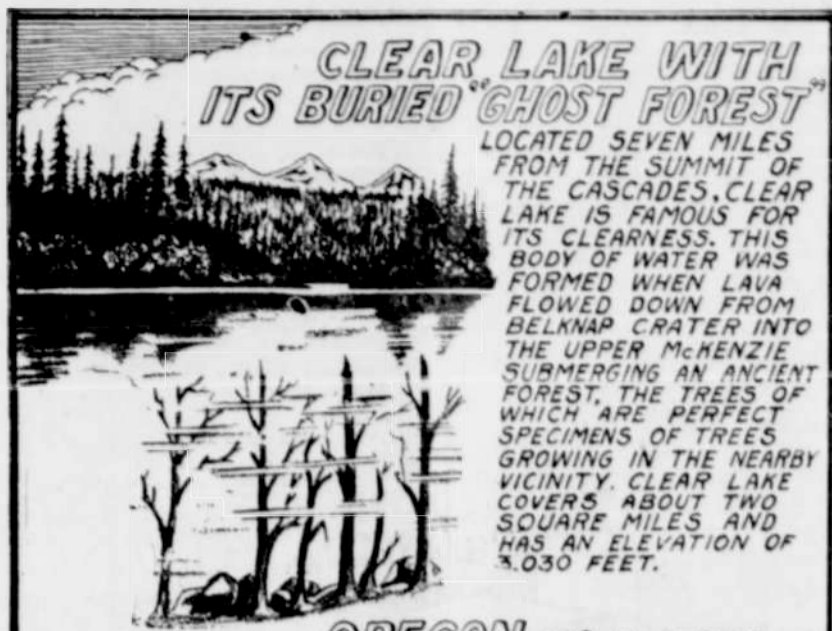

CLEAR LAKE WITH ITS BURIED GHOST FOREST LOCATED SEVEN MILES FROM THE SUMMIT OF THE CASCADES. CLEAR LAKE IS FAMOUS FOR ITS CLEARNESS. THIS BODY OF WATER WAS FORMED WHEN LAVA FLOWED DOWN FROM ELKNAP CRATER INTO THE UPPER MCENZIE SUBMERGING AN ANCIENT FOREST, THE TREES OF WHICH ARE PERFECT SPECIMENS OF TREES GROWING IN THE NEARBY VICINITY. CLEAR LAKE COVERS ABOUT TWO SQUARE MILES AND HAS AN ELEVATION OF 3,030 FEET.
