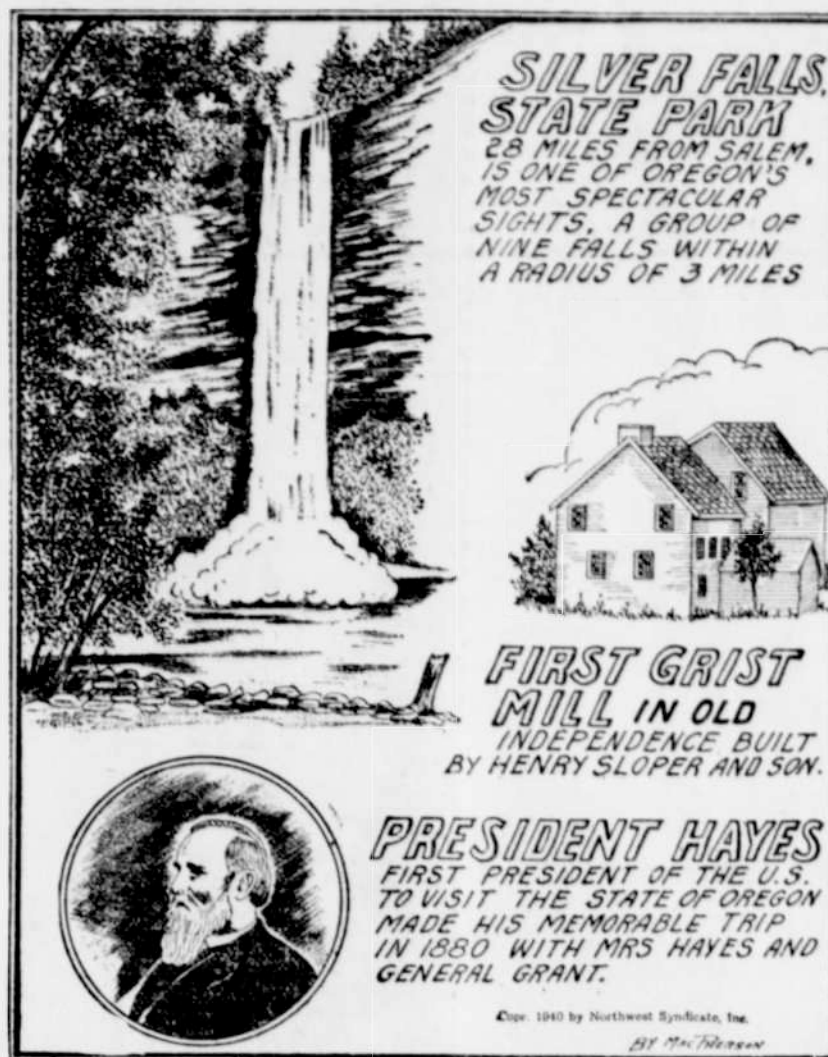

Grow Bedding Plants in Spruce Veneer Plant Bands

Few of us realize the check or damaging effect of taking young plants from open soil and transplanting them. Some plants in the greenhouse apparently are not as much affected but we know from long experience that asters, mums, peas and many others show this checking affected strikingly when transplanted even in a protected greenhouse. Planting outdoors will check them severely.
