huge agricultural outlays only hastens the day when Congress must boost taxes for both farm and factory. And higher taxes will raise further the prices of city-made goods which the farmer says he already cannot afford to buy.

Subsidies Here to Stay
Seven years of fruitless handouts ought to prove to even the hardest-of-heart that farm prosperity cannot be legislated or bought. However, one does not have to look far to find the reason for Congress' great concern for the farmers again this year. Certain farm blocs are well-organized and speak for big blocs of voters.

The politicians have their big feet planted solidly in the farm problem and it will be no easy task to yank them out. Handouts and subsidies will bulk large in the "farm economics" for the years to come. Government checks will continue to be stuffed into R.F.D. mail boxes.

There is nothing unusual in the procedure. I am not blaming the farmers. Other groups are "getting theirs." Why should the farmers be shy at "handout time?" But the farm problem will never be solved by subsidies, benefits, relief. It will only go from bad to worse until nature's laws of rewards and punishments are allowed again to function freely. Perhaps if farmers should organize into strong unions and force their prices up artificially just as labor has done, it might bring both the unions and the politicians to their senses!

New Uses Needed
Basically, however, the answer lies in finding new industrial uses for farm products; but this solution is too far off too intangible to satisfy the politicians. Consequently, billions more will be spent in trying to buy farm prosperity (and incidentally the farm vote). Again I say that only in a government could a management spend 3,000,000,000 and, without showing any results, get away with it! Or can they? November 5 will tell the story. It will be a vital story, because the selection of 1940 will be the most significant since 1860!

So much for farm politics; but let me add another word. As I traveled during the past week through our great Central West, I wondered whether any of us should complain. Conditions at their worst in America are better than in any other country in the world. And of this I know because I have visited most of them. As I saw the sun rise over the great fertile plains of Illinois, blessed with an abundance of seed, rain, and freedom, I said a prayer of thankfulness and resolved—whatever might come to me—I shall never complain!

Bacteria Cause Explosions

Scotland Yard for months was puzzled by mysterious explosions in gasoline storage tanks holding wartime fuel. Sabotage was suspected but unproved. Finally a kerosene tank blew up. A quick examination after the explosion showed bubbles of gas rising from the layer of water at the tank's bottom on which the kerosene had been floating. Taking some of the water and sediment to a laboratory, it was discovered a new kind of bacteria which can live in kerosene and ferment it into 10 per cent ethane and 90 per cent methane. It was the explosive methane and ethane gas generated by these bacteria which caused the explosions.

First Modern Aviator

The present widespread interest in aviation and the expansion of the United States airlines into South America recalls the fact that the first flight made in a self-propelled flying machine was the flight by Alberto Santos-Dumont, who was born in Sao Paulo, Brazil, in 1873. Records show he made a flight in Paris in an elongated balloon propelled by a gasoline engine in 1898 and, in 1906, made a flight in a machine built on the principle of the box kite. A monument to the memory of Santos-Dumont is found in the city of Sao Paulo today.

Meaning of 'Suspended'

A youthful motorist was haled into Salt Lake police court on a charge of driving a car with faulty license plates. The defendant said the plates had just fallen and he was heading for a garage to get them fixed. The judge fined him \$5, but added: "Fine suspended." The youth started reaching in his pocket for the money. The judge suggested he look up the courtroom dictionary. The defendant, returned blushing, thanked the judge—and departed.
