Albany College Pioneer Institution of Oregon

Albany College was founded in 1867 at Albany, Oregon, by the Presbyterian Church.

The move to Portland in 1938 was made because of need of an additional four-year college for a large number of high school graduates not able to finance college education away from home.

The aim of the Board of Trustees of Albany College is to provide an institution of higher learning on a Christian foundation, dedicated to the highest standards of scholarship and based on the highest ideals of Christian character. Albany College, a truly democratic institution is open to all high school graduates of good character, regardless of race or creed.

Under the leadership of President Clarence W. Greene students learn that college is a place in which to prepare for a useful life—to learn how to work and to live amicably with their fellow men. A spirit of hopefulness, optimism and expectation pervades the institution, indicating a strong school morale and unity. One of the endeavors of Albany College is to do a quality job of education; not merely to develop keen intellects, but the ability to do constructive thinking and apply it usefully. Students of Albany College have every opportunity to achieve this goal through the close personal contact with faculty members.

Many natural advantages are available to students attending college in a metropolitan city, such as greater opportunity to work to earn their way, exceptional library facilities, and contact with outstanding personalities.

The maintenance in Portland of four-old colleges with their many varied activities results in a large cultural contribution to the life of the community. For example, the music department of Albany College presented soloists and groups on 525 programs, exclusive of college functions, during the past college year.

To promote the immediate development of the enlarged college program, an appeal for \$500,000 is now being made. Of this amount \$400,000 will be used for the purchase and development of the new college site and the construction and equipment of buildings, and \$100,000 will be placed in a reserve fund.

The proposed campus site extends from Southeast 64th Avenue to Southeast 70th Avenue and lies between Southeast Stark Street and Southeast Thorburn Street. The tract is of gently rolling character and is admirably adapted for the construction of college buildings and the development of an artistic campus. From the tract one may see sections of the Willamette and Columbia Rivers, Mt. Hood and Mt. St. Helens and most of Portland's business district and residential area.

Albany College has already brought to Portland over one third of a million dollars in endowment and equipment.


