

TRACTOR DRIVING CONTEST FINALS TO BE HELD MONDAY NEAR NEWBERG

Youth from Northwest to Receive Ford
Tractor as First Prize

Ten awards are awaiting the best young farmers in this area to climax the finals of a sectional tractor operating contest for members of the National Farm Youth Foundation at the Walter Everest Hop Yard southeast of Newberg, just off U. S. Highway No. 99W, Monday, October 21, at 1:30 p.m.

Members of the Foundation from Oregon, Washington and Idaho who have won earlier local elimination and semi-final contests directed by Ford tractor dealers and distributors will be matching furrows on identical tractor and tool equipment supplied by R. M. Wade & Company Tractor Sales Division, Ford tractor distributor for the Pacific Northwest, who is acting as host for the finals.

In the Pacific Northwest contests there have been 500 National Farm Youth boys participating. Elimination contests were held and semi-final contests have now reduced the number of finalists to the ten who will participate on Monday.

The finals are being sponsored by the Ferguson-Sherman Manufacturing Corporation, Dearborn, Michigan, who are offering as first award a new Ford tractor with two-bottom Ferguson plow.

Based on a scale of points, the young operators will be judged on straightness of opening furrows; neatness of back furrow; evenness of entering and leaving land at headland furrow; keeping furrow straight at each end of field; evenness of furrow slices; evenness of furrow depth, covering trash; straightness of furrow wall; neatness of dead furrow and finishing plowing job without undue loss of time.

The National Farm Youth Foundation was established on May 15 of this year to bring practical, up-to-date principles of farm management and engineering to young men living or working on American farms. It is sponsored by the Ferguson-Sherman Manufacturing Corporation, with the active cooperation of Mr. Henry Ford and Mr. Edsel Ford, R. M. Wade & Co. Tractor Sales Division, Northwest Ford tractor distributors and dealers, who sell the Ford tractor and Ferguson system implements.

Twenty-nine final contests in each of which new Ford tractors and other valuable awards will be offered are being conducted in farming areas over the country.

"These contests are part of the Foundation program to stimulate interest in modern farming methods and to determine proficiency among young farmers. Fifty-eight national Foundation winners will eventually receive salaried jobs under contract with Ferguson-Sherman manufacturing and Ford tractor distributors," explained Mr. Wade Newbegin, president of R. M. Wade & Co. Tractor Sales Division.

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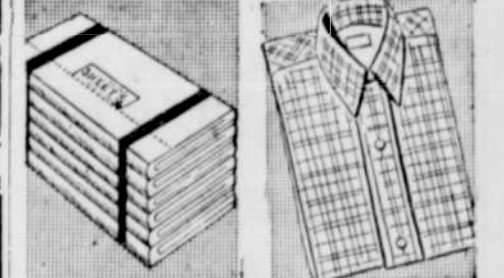
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
