Dog License Notice

The license fees for licensable dogs over the age of eight months and for such dogs owned or kept within the State of Oregon over 30 days for the year 1941 are:

- MALE DOG \$1.00
- FEMALE DOG \$1.50
- SPAYED FEMALE DOG \$1.00

After March 1st, 1941, the license fee is \$1.00 more for failure to procure license for the dogs above stated. Also, after March 1st, 1941, the fee is \$1.00 more for failure to procure licenses for licensable dogs becoming over 8 months of age after March 1st, 1941, and for dogs over eight months old owned or kept within the State of Oregon over 30 days after March 1st, 1941.

Licenses may be ordered by mail. State the name and address of the person to whom the license is to be issued, and the sex of the dog.

Fees are payable to W. A. TUPPER, County Clerk Hillsboro, Oregon. Published by Order of the County Court of Washington County, Oregon.

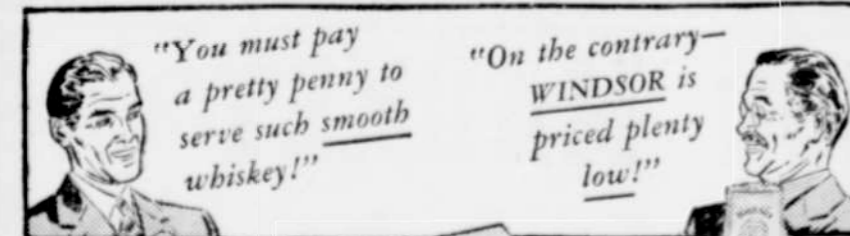
