Huge Ship-Building Program Planned

It has finally been decided by Government officials to go ahead with the vast new program of merchant-shipbuilding. Inside New Dealers are reported to feel that they have won a victory over the more conservative officials in securing this decision. Those who watched the break-up of the great fleet following the first World War are wondering what will happen to the great new fleet after this war is ended.

Uncle Sam & Soviet Union

The trade agreement prevailing between the U.S.S.R. and the United States has been extended until Aug. 6, 1942. The Department of State reports "although it is expected... the character and amount of United States trade with the Soviet Union will be governed largely by the defense needs of the United States and of the Soviet Union... rather than by the usual commercial considerations, the exchange of notes will ensure the continuance during the emergency period of our established commercial relations with the Soviet Union on the basis of the 1937 commercial agreement." The notes, signed Aug. 2, were exchanged by Soviet Ambassador Oumansky and Under Secretary of States Welles. The agreement provides speedy delivery of needed materials to Russia and priorities for Soviet orders in the U. S. on the same basis extended other anti-Axis governments. The Department said the Soviet Union pledged its resistance to Germany will "correspond in magnitude" to the economic assistance thus received. Russia will pay cash or earmark gold for all materials bought.

One war relief activity which has been little publicized is The Christian Science War Relief Committee, with main offices in Boston, Mass. 2,999 cases—half a million garments—valued at \$489,368.23, in the nine months of the committee's existence, is their record to date.

The work is an activity of The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, and branch Churches throughout America. Only new garments or those comparable to new are accepted by the committee. These are furnished almost entirely by members of the Christian Science organizations. They are shipped to London and allocated to England and garments are distributed to any person in need, regardless of denomination.

Not only are garments made by sewing units in about thirteen hundred places throughout the United States, but thousands of new garments are purchased and sent, from a War Relief Fund generously contributed by Christian Scientists. Three motor kitchens have been sent and a motor truck or van is maintained in England for quick deliveries.

The main depot for shipping to England is located in Boston, but shipments are also made from other cities and from Portland, Oregon, where the shipping depot is located at 622 Southwest Columbia street, and the workroom at 1237 American Bank Building, where used material may also be sent.
