stop our tax blitzkrieg and give this money confidence to come out and serve the nation.

Let's Spend More on Research
If statesmen would spend 1-10th of their time in developing new uses for waste products—instead of increasing taxes—no increase in tax rates would now be necessary. As often said, the chances for increased income and employment through research are beyond the fondest dreams. It is our only hope for preventing a post-war collapse.

Raw cotton is worth only 12 cents a pound; but put it into new fibres and it is worth a dollar per pound. Petroleum is worth only 5 cents per gallon as fuel oil; but put it into dyes and it is worth many times this. Soya beans used to be treated as weeds; but today are a most sought for crop. Coal sells for only a few dollars a ton to burn; but it is worth several hundred dollars per ton when turned into nylon silk. Even sea water is becoming useful for making magnesia and bromine.

The Solution
The real way to raise the new money needed for defense is to increase the national income and leave tax rates as they are. This can be done by reducing crime, suppressing commercialized evils and encouraging new industries. Both the U. S. and Canada need more engineers and fewer politicians. Some will say "this means a spiritual re-birth of the American people." Well,—why not work for this? There is no short cut to either prosperity or security. The Ten Commandments and the Multiplication Table give the answer to taxation.

Getting Things From God

Away before daybreak, Christ slipped out to a place apart and there He prayed. And why must such a One as He pray? Was He not Creator of the universe? All things were made by Him and without Him was not anything made that was made. Then why must He pray?

Also the Holy Spirit makes intercession for us "with pleadings that cannot be uttered." And we pray to get things from God.

On Prayer Ground—ONE: Christ received as Savior. "No man cometh to the Father but Me," said Christ. **TWO—Every wrong righted;** every sin confessed.—"Now we know that God heareth not sinners, but if any man be a worshipper of God and doeth His will, him he heareth." John 9:31.

THREE—Plead the Bible promises. FOR—"He that spareth not his own there is one for ever hard place. Son but delivered Him up; for us all, how shall he not with Him freely give us all things?"
