load held above \$10.75. Good grass
heifers \$8.50 to \$9.25 part of a load
to \$10. Good beef cows \$7.75 to \$8.25,
medium \$7 to \$7.50, common \$6 to
\$6.50, canners \$4.50 to \$5.50. Bulls
medium to good \$8.25 to \$9.50, com-
mon \$7 to \$8. Vealers good to choice
\$12 to \$13.
HOGS: Good to choice carlots
\$10 to \$10.25; 170 to 215 lb truckins
\$10 to \$10.25; 230 to 285 lb butchers
\$9.25 to \$9.75; lightweight butchers
\$9.25 to \$9.50; packing sows \$7.75 to
\$8.50. Feeder pigs \$10 to \$11.50.

lambs \$10 to \$10.50 a few \$10.60 to

Cat Lovers' Notes

Kittens should be weaned at five
to seven weeks of age.
Don't pick up a cat by its front
legs. Legs are sometimes broken
by doing this. Grasp them around
the body just behind the front legs.
At this point the body balances nicely
in your hands, and there is no
danger of injury.
Don't pick up cats of any age by
the skin of the neck or back. This
hurts them unnecessarily.
Don't lose your temper in hand-
ling cats. Man is presumably of
superior intelligence, but if he loses
his temper in handling a cat or kites
ten, by so doing he raises a question
as to which is the smarter.
The teeth of a cat accumulate tar-
tar which should be removed and the
teeth cleaned to prevent sore
gums and decay of teeth. Any de-
cayed teeth should be extracted.
According to the International Cat
Society there are one hundred and
twenty million cats in the United
States or approximately as many
cats as there are humans. The pity
of it is that the society estimates
that about 65% of these cats are
"strays."
The cat when sick has the charac-

seventy-five 50-cent stamps; or sev-
enty-five \$1 stamps; or fifteen \$5
stamps. The completed album are
immediately exchangeable for De-
fense Bonds ((Series E) at your post
office, or through your bank.
Q Who directs the National move-
ment to sell Defense Savings Stamps
