Know Your Oregon. A BLAZE FROM THE SKY!! WEIGHING OVER 15 TONS THE WILLAMETTE METEOR DISCOVERED 19 MILES SOUTH OF PORTLAND IN 1902 IS THE LARGEST TO HAVE BEEN DISCOVERED IN THE U.S. THIS METEOR IS ON DISPLAY AT THE ENTRANCE OF THE AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY IN NEW YORK. METEORS ARE BITS OF COMETS BUT WE SEE THEM AS STREAKS OF FIRE (AS ILLUSTRATION SHOWS) BUT WHEN THEY HIT THE EARTH THE HOLES THEY MAKE IN THE SURFACE END THEIR CAREER. THE FIRST STEAMBOAT BUILT IN OREGON WAS THE 'COLUMBIA' NAMED IN HONOR OF THE FIRST SHIP TO ENTER THE COLUMBIA RIVER. IT WAS LAUNCHED AT ASTORIA JULY 3, 1850. THE SECOND BUILT WAS THE 'LOT WILKOMB' LAUNCHED AT MILWAUKIE CHRISTMAS DAY 1850. THE FIRST FOUR LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS OR COUNTIES IN OREGON TERRITORY WERE TWALY, CLACKAMAS, YAMHILL AND CHAMPOEG.

MOVIE STAR JOINS U.S. NAVY



Ensign Wayne Morris Seeks Wings

Wayne Morris, recent star of "I Wanted Wings," became a member of Uncle Sam's Navy in May, 1941, when he was appointed to the rank of Ensign.

When asked what he thought of the United States Navy, Morris said, "I think every man who is considering joining a military service should look into the 'chance of a lifetime' which the Navy and Naval Reserve offer to get into the big-pay field of the future—aviation. In the Navy you can attend the finest flight training schools in the world, and receive in-

struction from Navy pilots who introduced dive bombing, aircraft carriers and catapult take-offs to the rest of the world. Also, there are opportunities in Naval Aviation for men who don't want to fly. They can be trained as aviation machinists, metallurgists, photographers, observers, or they can receive instruction in many other trades. It's a great life in the Navy."

Manufacturers and wholesalers are urging retailers to stock up. Retail inventories are now very high and orders for future deliveries of new merchandise are higher than current inventories. However, to date, retailers have not generally marked up prices to meet increased wholesale prices. They may have to do so after current inventories are exhausted.

With more people employed and some having higher wages, more cash is available to spend today than in a good many years. As a result, people are demanding the very best and the higher-priced goods. However, in many instances they could and should, buy the cheaper lines of merchandise. For example, a pair of men's good shoes can be bought for \$3.60. It certainly is not necessary to pay \$8.50, or more.

Cost of Food

Some food prices are up; many are the same as, or lower than, a year ago. For example, canned soups have not risen, nor have fresh fruits and vegetables. Meat sales and prices are both rising; but beef is still a good value compared with a year ago. Salmon has gone up; but crab meat is lower. Rice, dressed poultry, corn, and sugar are also among the items which have not had any appreciable upward move.

Watch the newspaper ads and buy things which are plentiful, as squash and apples are now. Buy cheaper cuts of meat. Bottom of the round sells in Boston for 32 cents a pound and has as much food value as sirloin at 65 cents. Why buy for "tenderness" when you can get as much nourishment for less money and have a smaller dental bill? There is a 3-5 cent difference between canned "standard" peas and "fancy" peas. The standard pea has more food value and costs less. The fancy pea looks and tastes better.

Cost of Shelter

Building costs, including materials and labor, are about 12% above a year ago. Before building a new house today prospective home-owners should perhaps consider the purchase of foreclosed property from banks and insurance companies. Much of this property is available and has been put into good shape. Such property may be financed on a modest down payment and easy monthly installments. Thus the total cost of owning a house today may be even less than in the past if people will take time to shop around.

The rise in date in the overall cost of living is fully compensated for by the fact that there has been a continual increase in the number of people employed. This monthly increase is now running at the rate of about 450,000 persons. As some one member of a family heretofore unemployed, gets employment, this raises the total family income and compensates for any increase in the cost-of-living.

Combating Living Costs

Some 80% of our workers are en-

gaged in non-defense industries which cannot possibly pay increased wages. Civil service and other government employees are in the same boat. They will feel rising living costs more than any other group. The 5% minority group can readily adjust themselves to meet higher prices. Most of those, however, who are not in the defense industries must change their purchasing habits. This 80% of our people will surely have to be content with wasting less and spending less on their car. They can do much, however, to combat rising living costs by shifting their purchases from items that have gone up to items that have not gone up. This can be done. We can all remember the old New England proverb—"Eat it up—Wear it out—and Make it do!"

Defense Bond Quiz

Q When will the "drive" to sell Defense Savings Bonds begin?

A There will be no "drive." Many people think of the Defense Savings Program as like the Liberty Loan campaigns of the first World War, which were conducted for stated periods to raise specific quotas. The Defense Savings Program is a long-range, continuing effort to stimulate the public to buy more and more Defense Bonds and Stamps month by month, and is essentially a program to promote mass saving, as well as to provide money for defense.

Q Are the Defense Savings Stamps sold at retail stores exchangeable for Defense Savings Bonds?

A Yes. They are the same as Stamps on sale at post offices and elsewhere.

NOTE: To buy Defense Bonds and Stamps, go to the nearest post-office, bank, or savings and loan association; or write to the Treasurer of the United States, Washington, D. C. Also Stamps now are on sale at retail stores.
