Continued from page 1 55,000 gardens of Oregon and processed or canned at home in containers usually on hand, a tremendous amount of labor and material would be saved. In addition to these actual savings in materials and labor which are becoming scarce and will become scarcer, producing and preserving these vegetables at home releases an equivalent amount of the commercial pack to be turned over to their allies on the lend-lease program or to take care of the stepped up domestic consumer demand. Gardens are extremely important. Goals for production for the commercial pack of vegetables have been set at extremely high figures. Forty million cases of canned tomatoes, 38,000,000 cases of canned peas, 22,000,000 cases of canned corn, and 18,000,000 cases of canned string beans, have been set as goals for the

American producer to reach in his 1942 production. Such supplies are necessary to meet the demands of our civilian, military, and lend-lease needs during the 1942-1943 season. Because of these extraordinary demands the thrifty farmer and canny home gardener will readily see the advisability of doing which is practical to produce their own vegetables. To grow a successful garden means that there must be sufficient fertility in the land to grow thrifty and healthy plants. On the farm that problem is usually easily and quickly solved by the application of a generous amount of barnyard manure. The same material rates the number one place in supplying the necessary fertility for the back yard gardener. Where it cannot be obtained, commercial fertilizers are sometimes necessarily resorted to. These are valuable but should be purchased for a specific purpose and used judiciously. There are differences in varieties of vegetables. The gardener can well afford to spend a little time looking over the catalog of a good seed house and selecting those varieties which are marked as preferable. After such a list has been made, the local retail seed dealer may then be approached and the purchase of the necessary seeds made by calling for the varieties listed. After a suitable seed bed is prepared, good seed put in the ground, then the home gardener can start in controlling the weeds, the insect pests, and the diseases, says Cyrus. There is plenty to do but there is also a tremendous satisfaction in producing some of the things needed for the home table and in realizing at the same time that we are contributing just one more bit towards helping in our war cause through releasing other vegetable food supplies for our fighting forces and to help maintain the morale of our allied peoples, the agent said.
