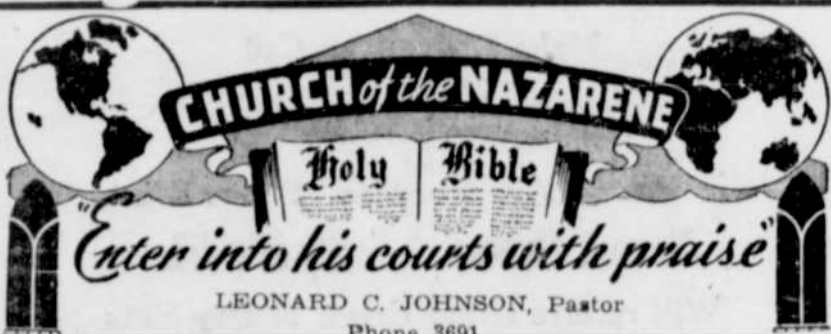
It has been announced that William J. Gallagher, 69, of Minneapolis, a former street cleaner and railroad laborer, was elected Congressman at the polls November 7.

Changes Worship of Japs

NEW YORK.—Because of the danger of U. S. air raids, Jap authorities in Korea have abandoned the use of a siren to summon the population for twice-a-day compulsory worship of Emperor Hirohito, it was disclosed by a broadcast over the controlled Keijo radio, reported today to the Office of War Information. Trumpet calls and the rendition of a song called "On to the Sea" have been broadcast at 7 a. m. and noon by local radios as a substitute for the siren, which has been restricted to use as a raid warning "in order to be prepared to meet the raids of enemy planes," said the Keijo broadcast.
