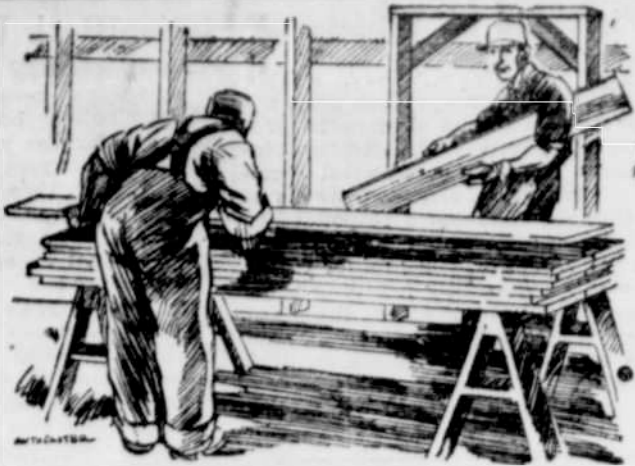

Looking Backward

On April 27, 1822, Gen. U. S. Grant was born in the presidential state of Ohio and on the same date in the year 1897 Grants tomb was dedicated in New York.

On the same date in 1938, Admiral Simpson's squadron bombarded Cuba. Yesterday in history—in 1665 the Great Plague broke out in London. In 1865 Steamer Sultana burned in the Mississippi burned and on this date in 1914, the American flag was raised at Vera Cruz, Mexico, and the city placed under martial law.

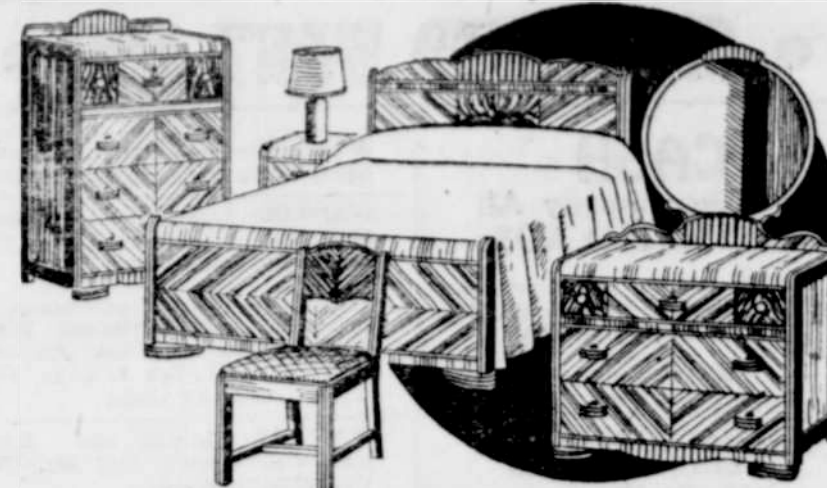
LEGAL NOTICE
