OREGON farms successfully grow all of the standard hay-grain-hog items that are usually identified with farm operation, but they also offer opportunities not found in other sections for unusual crops of high value. Rich soil, long growing season and dry summers, enables the production of large yields of specialty crops such as lawn and pasture grass seed, clover and seed peas, bulbs, flax, prunes, cherries, berries, filberts, walnuts, holly, nursery stock and others. Irrigation, feasible for many farms, enables high production of vegetables for canning and freezing. Irrigated summer pastures yield enormous tonnage of rich forage for dairy herds. Oregon's Willamette Valley is of about the same size and degree of fertility as Holland but has only about 10% as much population, which facts suggest a great future for this section.
