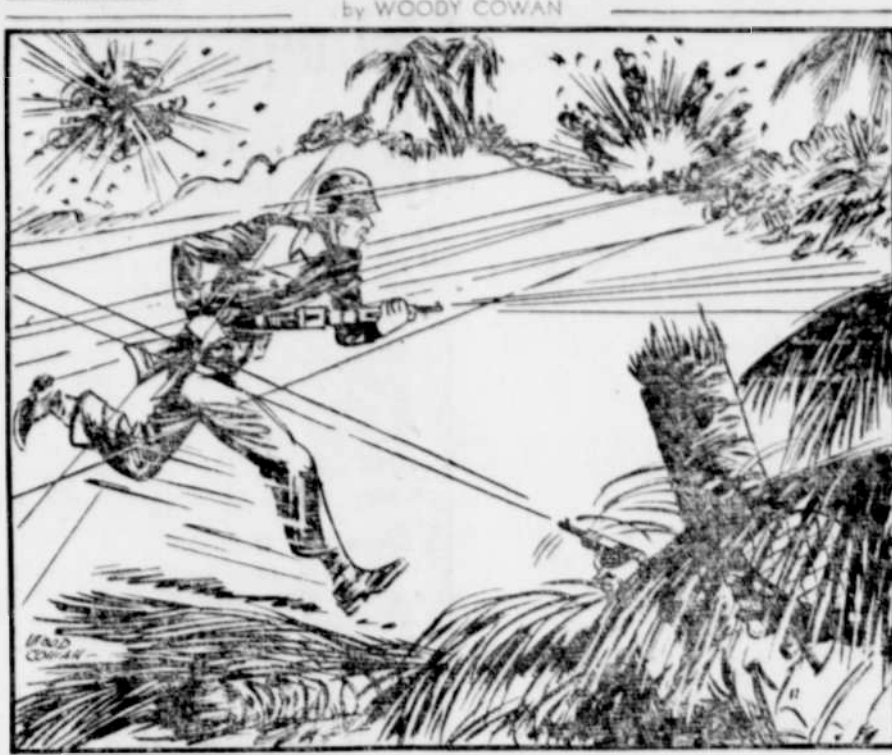

Struck time and again, he killed two of the enemy and forced the others to withdraw before his last fall. The Medal of Honor was awarded him posthumously.

U. S. Increase in 1945

WASHINGTON. — The Secretary of Labor reported recently that industrial injuries increased slightly during the first three months of 1945 and constituted a "serious drain on the nation's manpower."

A survey by the bureau of labor statistics showed that some 159,000 workers were injured during the three-month period with a loss of about 3,180,000 days of work.
