Captain Clark and party, now reduced to thirteen, proceeded eastward and camped in the future site of Logan. Following a buffalo route, they passed through an easy gap in the mountains (Bozeman pass) between the Yellowstone and Gallatin rivers. The route passed the future site of Bozeman striking the Yellowstone near the present Livingston. The feet of their horses becoming worn and tender, moccasins were made for them and the buffalo and deer afforded pleasant relief. Hunting was good, their men's bellies were full and their spirits high. Tributaries of the Yellowstone were named Shield's river and Bratton's river (Bridge creek), for members of the party.
