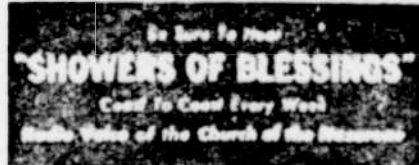

Tate on Way Home

Pearl Harbor, T. H., Ashel H. Tate, SFC, husband of Mrs. Agnes V. Tate, of Aloha, is on his way home. Tate is one of over 4,200 high-point Navy veterans whom the "Magic Carpet" is bringing back to the States aboard the U.S.S. Yorktown. The U.S.S. Yorktown—one of more than 250 carriers, battleships, cruisers, and attack transports in the Navy's famed "Magic Carpet" fleet—left Guam, November 17, and is scheduled to arrive in San Francisco about December 1.
Passengers will go directly to the Separation Centers nearest their homes to complete the formalities of obtaining their discharges before returning to civilian life.
