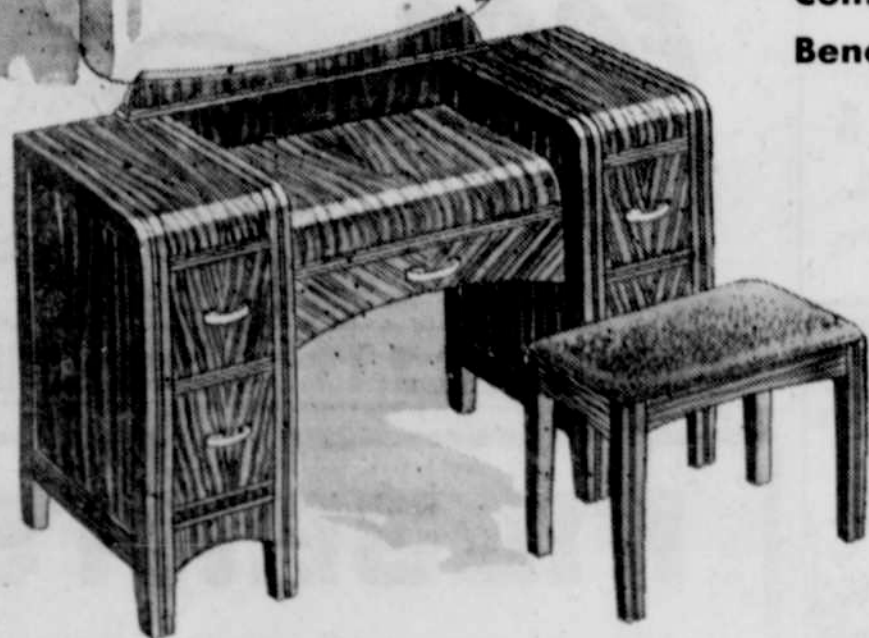
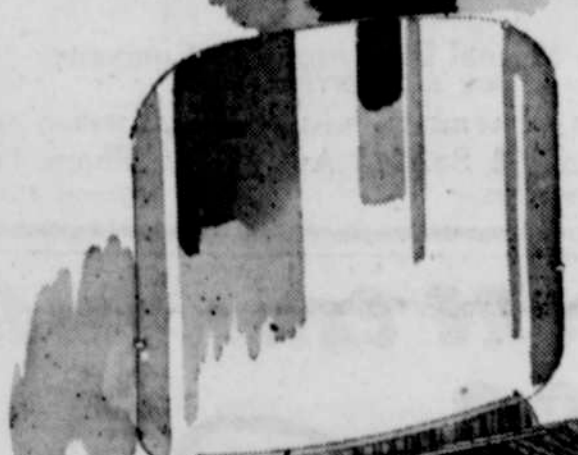
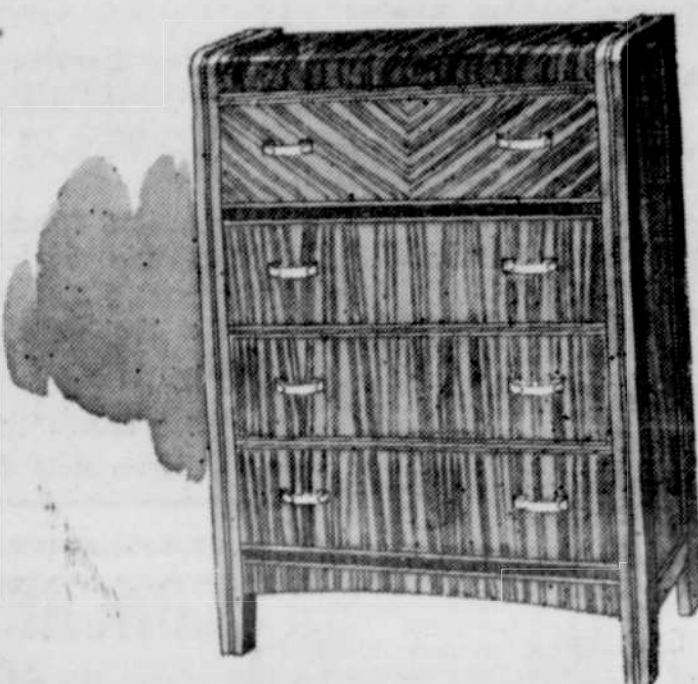

D. 1946, between the hours of 2 o'clock p. m. and 7 o'clock p. m. there will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of contracting a bonded indebtedness in the sum of \$280,000.00 for the purpose of providing funds with which to alter the present building and grounds to purchase equipment to construct an addition to the present building, to provide separate buildings and equip same on property owned by the union high school district number 10 Joint, Washington and Multnomah Counties, Oregon, in and for said school district.
