Price Administration Information

Restaurants that customarily charge higher prices during passover week and on Easter Sunday may continue to do so during the coming observance of these holidays, providing they do not charge more than 15 per cent above their filed Sunday prices for the same meals or items, the Office of Price Administration announced today.

These exceptions from the General April 4-10, 1943, Restaurant Price Freeze, effective April 12, 1946, are allowed because it is a customary trade practice for some restaurants to charge higher prices during passover week as well as on Easter Sunday for special meals and food items. Both of these exceptions were permitted last year.

OPA emphasized that restaurants which customarily have not charged more than their usual prices during passover or Easter Sunday cannot ask higher prices this year.

CONSTRUCTION STARTED ON BEAVERTON WOODWORKING AND BUILDERS PLANT

Construction was started this week on the new home of the Beaverton Woodworkers and Builders located on the Tualatin Hiway and the East city limits of Beaverton. The structure will be 67½x72 feet and the permit applied for a \$12,000 building.

This business is the culmination of an idea which has been brewing for many years in the minds of two Beaverton men, Lloyd W. Shriner, who is the owner and builder, and Maurice N. Romig. These men were classmates at Oregon State College, both are ex Portland school teachers.

The building when completed will be a fine addition to Beaverton and from the drawings will be appealing to the eye as well as having a design which will be efficient to work in.

The building will be built of red tile and will have a brick front, the floors throughout will be of cement. An apartment, which will be the residence of Mr. Shriner will be built atop the manufacturing plant.

A rather unique roof design will permit natural light to the working space below the apartment.

When completed, the building will house the complete woodworking plant, the Rainbow Electric Construction Company, and another space will be available for some other business. This has not been allocated at the present time.
