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Wheat Sale Program From AAA Office

Oregon wheat producers can obtain from county AAA offices full details of the emergency wheat purchase program through which producers who sell their wheat now will receive the benefit of any price increase between now and April 1, 1947. Closing date of the purchase plan is July 1, 1946.

The purchase program is expected to accelerate a campaign to "sweep out the bins," previously pledged by producers in Columbia basin counties as their contribution to the food-for-famine relief program, according to E. Harvey Miller, state director of the Production and Marketing Administration, USDA, and manager of Oregon's emergency food program.

Pointing out that every extra bushel marketed now will save lives of starving people abroad, Miller urged farmers to sell down to the minimum supplies needed for feed until harvest. He added that supplies of wheat still on farms in Oregon are small, probably not exceeding 5 per cent of the 1945 crop.

USDA Office of PMA to Move To Portland Soon

State offices of the field service branch, USDA Production and Marketing Administration, will move from Corvallis to the Eastern building, Tenth and Washington streets, Portland, on April 29th, it is announced by E. Harvey Miller, state PMA director.

The move will complete the consolidation brought about by last fall's reorganization in the department of agriculture of the former state Agricultural Adjustment agency (AAA) office, with the Portland staff of the former USDA Office of Supply.

The agency has been located on the Oregon State college campus since the AAA program was established 12 years ago. N. E. Dodd, Baker county rancher who was first state AAA committee chairman, recently was appointed undersecretary of Agriculture.

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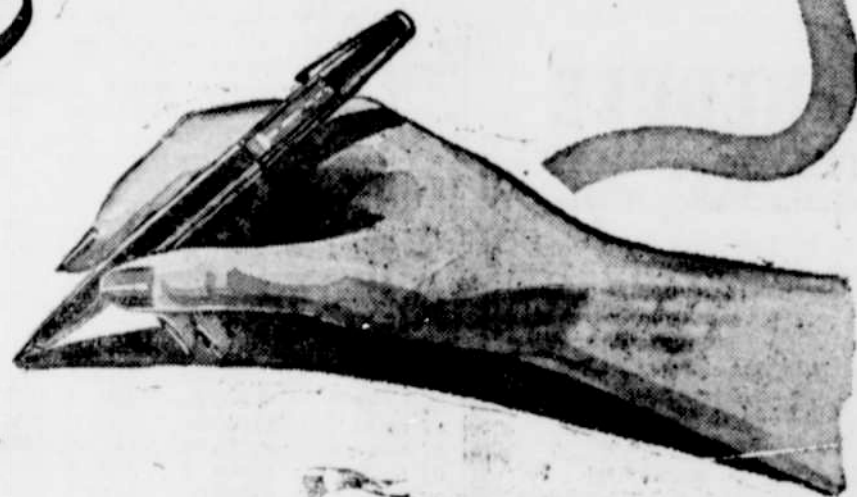
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rate through the use of an electric range and water heater in your home, and have not already done so, be sure to apply immediately. All your service will be billed under a single meter. Your minimum monthly bill will be \$4.50, for which you will receive 300 kwh. of electricity. Additional amounts of electricity you may consume are billed as follows: the next 700 kwh. at 6/10 of a cent per kwh.; excess use over 1000 kwh. at 85/100 of a cent per kwh. If in addition to cooking and water heater service, full electric house heating is used, billings may include a small demand charge dependent on the size of the installation and the manner of its use.
