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Huge Tuna Pack Seen For Oregon

Tuna fish canned in Oregon and Washington represents nearly one-fifth of this country's annual tuna pack, a survey by American Can Company shows, according to E. H. Bell, vice president.

With tuna boats and most of the crews now back on a peacetime basis, Mr. Bell said the study indicated the 1946 pack may exceed that of all past seasons. He pointed to survey figures which showed the 1944 pack in Oregon was 13,041,000 pounds, while in Washington the pack was 1,260,000 pounds.

Another indication of a possible record pack, Mr. Bell added, was the unusually heavy demand for tuna cans. He said the can-making industry is optimistic that food packers' needs will be filled, despite shortages of materials.
