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Farm Laborers Are Needed Now

With bean harvest nearing the peak, and hop picking of the early cluster variety due to start August 15, the farm labor demand is picking up sharply, reports Roy L. Davidson, Farm Labor Assistant. All yards of early cluster hops will be in operation by August 19, and picking will continue through the late varieties until the middle of September.

Hop growers will furnish transportation from Hillsboro, Cornelius and Forest Grove. Pickers should contact the Farm Labor Office for time and place of pick ups.

Early varieties of peaches are now being picked, and regular canning varieties are starting during the next few days. There is some demand for pickers. Prune picking of early canning varieties will start around the twenty-eighth of August.

The Hillsboro Farm Labor Camp is now practically completed with

all inside plumbing, laundry rooms hot showers, and wash rooms installed in the central utility building. The tents are equipped with cook stove, table, and cots with mattresses. These tents are 12 by 14 feet and rent for five dollars per week, with wood and water furnished free.

Occupants of the camp will have almost steady work, beginning with hops and carrying through beans, prunes, onions, fiberts and walnuts. Walnut harvest is not finished until early November.

Living facilities may be had in the Hillsboro camp, by contacting the Farm Labor Office, Court-house, Hillsboro, Phone 2171 or the camp itself, Hillsboro phone 3321.

Rates Increased For Wheat Loans

Wheat loan rates on the 1946 crop will average about 10 1/2 cents above last year for all Oregon stations, as a result of a 3-cent increase above the original 8-cent

raise announced last week. About one-half cent of the three cent boost was absorbed by higher freight rates, which are used in calculating differentials between terminal and country point loan values.

The terminal loan rate at Portland now stands at \$1.60 a bushel. Loan rates for stations in this county are:
