**Junior Red Cross News**

Jean Kennelly, Hillsboro, Nora Lee Craven, Forest Grove and Irene VanKleeck, Beaverton, Junior Red Cross representatives of the Washington County Red Cross Chapter, writing home from Camp Celio, Nevada City, California, report that in spite of a heavy schedule at the Junior Red Cross Student Leaders' Camp, they are finding time for the informal exchange of ideas and experiences with students from other chapters. Ninety-seven boys and girls, representing five states and 56 Red Cross Chapters, begin their day with 6:30 a.m. reveille, and follow a daily schedule of classes in First Aid, Water Safety, Accident Prevention, Home Nursing, Nutrition, and work on the various aspects of Junior Red Cross organization and program, with lights out at 9:30 p.m. The classes are interspersed with supervised swimming, and recreation and excellent meals including mid-morning and mid-afternoon "snacks".

The camp faculty is composed of fifteen national and chapter members who have specialized in the various phases of the Junior Red Cross program which they are teaching. The student body is divided into five groups, each group working on some special project in addition to general instruction on organization and Red Cross courses. These groups rotate in taking responsibility for the operation of the camp for the entire day including the publication of a camp paper and an evening campfire program of music, stunts, movies, and addresses by visitors from National Headquarters and the U. S. Forestry Service.

Jean Kennelly states that Oregon has the greatest number of representatives there except California. She states there are 16 from Oregon. Jean states that she never thought much about Jr. Red Cross before but now as the result of the intensive training at the camp and ideas received from fellow students, she expects to give some practical assistance in bringing about better understanding and increased activity in Junior Red Cross. Nora Lee Craven, in her letter, reports working on gift boxes, and says "and Oh it's so much fun." It is just amazing what the need is for them. I believe they would be quite interested in doing."

Washington County Red Cross Chapter is fortunate in having 3 girls so very interested in this, their first Leadership Training Camp.

**O S C Forestry Leader Cited For War Service**

A certificate of meritorious service has been received by Dr. Phimister B. Proctor, head of the department of wood products in the school of forestry at OSC, for his work in the inspection section of the army air forces material command at Wright field in Ohio.

Dr. Proctor served as lieutenant colonel there for more than two years, supervising work used in aircraft and gliders and setting up a training program for inspectors. He cooperated with lumber and plywood industries in establishing controls over quality, drying and manufacturing procedures. He joined the O. S. C. staff upon his release from service in November 1945.

**County's Farm Income Shows Large Increase**

More than doubling their annual gross income in comparison with 1940, as reported by the U. S. Bureau of Census Washington County farm families last year produced crops and livestock with the record value of more than \$12,434,900.

This huge increase in farm revenue has already created heavy demand for general farm improvements and for home remodeling, according to a study released by the Tile Council of America. With every industry anticipating greater business in the state than before the war, floor and wall tile manufacturers alone expect their sales here to triple in the next few years.

"Increased sales of industrial products mean in turn a new level of prosperity for every local businessman and worker," said D. P. Forst, chairman of the Council's Residential Construction Committee.

The study shows that many farm improvements were made even during the war. Since 1940, for example, the number of farm homes reporting electric lights here has increased from 3,456 to 3,960. Heavy demand for such modernization as installation of running water, tiling of bathrooms and improving kitchen layouts has already resulted, according to Forst.

Forst also pointed out that farmers in the county today have 860 more tractors than in 1940, according to the Bureau of Census, and that the number of trucks on farms has likewise increased substantially. "These facts not only indicate the importance of the farm market but also make it one which no businessman or manufacturer can afford to overlook," he said.
