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Advice To Caneberry Growers

Caneberry growers who have plantings infected with lecanium scale should apply control measures at once states Palmer S. Torvend, county agent. Since opportunities to spray earlier have been somewhat limited a number of growers have not applied for their early spring spray as yet. Some canes are beginning to show new growth and standard dormant strength sprays must be used with care under these conditions. Normally, a dormant oil spray using 4 per cent actual oil is the recommended application. If leaf and cane spot disease has been a problem, control measures consist of an application of 3-50 bordeaux, applied just after the new leaves are out in the spring, or an application of dormant strength lime-sulphur applied during February or March will give control. If scale is not a problem, the bordeaux spray appears to give effective results. Growers who have adopted a spray program to control scale and leaf spots have increased yields as much as 30 per cent, Torvend reports.

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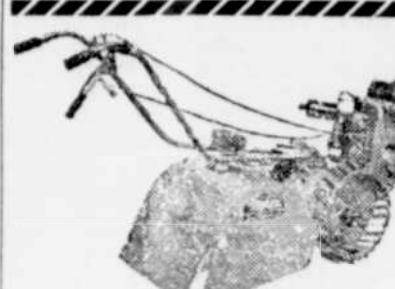

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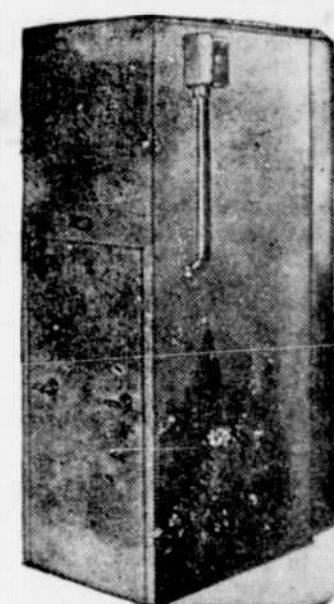
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
