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Receives Citation

Lt. Cdr. Clarence James Zurcher USN, of Beaverton, husband of Mrs. Marilyn M. Zurcher, has received the permanent citation for his Silver Star Medal from Secretary of the Navy James Forrestal, for the President.

Lt. Cdr. Zurcher, currently serving aboard the submarine USS Corsair with the Atlantic Fleet, earned the award serving as Assistant Approach Officer, Executive Officer and Navigator of the submarine USS Gunnel during its seventh war patrol in Japanese controlled waters. During this patrol he helped sink and damage over 25,000 tons of enemy shipping and carried out daring life-guard missions in the face of strong enemy anti-submarine measures.
