BUSY DAY CAKE

Submitted by Mrs. Ralph L. Davis of Benz Park Court

1/2 cup shortening—part butter, for flavor
1 cup sugar
2 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
1-3/4 cup sifted cake flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
2 1/2 cup milk which is at room temperature to make batter easier to mix.

1 egg
1 teaspoon flavoring

Sift flour, sugar, salt and baking powder in bowl. Add shortening, milk, egg and flavoring. Beat together with rotary beater for 2 minutes. Place in one 9 inch round layer pan or one 8-inch square pan. Bake for 25 to 35 minutes in 350 de. oven.

BRILLED "JIFFY" ICING

3 tablespoons melted butter.
5 tablespoons brown sugar
2 tablespoons cream or top milk
1/2 cup shredded coconut or chopped nuts, or a combination of the two.

Mix these ingredients and spread on still warm cake. Place under broiler which is turned on low. Broil until it bubbles and browns but does not burn.
