DOG LICENSE NOTICE

The license fees for licenseable dogs over the age of eight months and for dogs owned and kept within the State of Oregon over 30 days for the year 1948 are:

Male dog	\$1.00
Female Dog	\$1.50
Spayed Female Dog	\$1.00

After March 1st, 1948, the license fee is \$1.00 more for failure to procure license for the dogs above stated.

Also after March 1, 1948, the fee is \$1.00 more for failure to procure licenses for licenseable dogs becoming 8 months of age after March 1, 1948, and for dogs over 8 months old, owned, or kept within the State of Oregon over 30 days after March 1, 1948. Licenses may be ordered by mail.

State the name and address of the person to whom the license is to be issued, and the sex of the dog.
