Beginning at a point on the southerly line of "MATNEY'S ADDITION TO BEAVERTON", a subdivision of record in Washington County, Oregon from which point the southeast corner of Lot 12 of said "MATNEY'S ADDITION TO BEAVERTON" bears N 82° 11' W 30.0 feet, and the southwest corner of Lot 13 of said "MATNEY'S ADDITION TO BEAVERTON" bears S 82°

Beginning at the intersection of the easterly line of Hall Street extended, in the City of Beaverton, Oregon, with the northerly line of that tract of land in Section 15, T1S, R1W, W. M. conveyed to R. R. and Iva B. Summers by deed as recorded at Page 191 of Volume 132 of Washington County,

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly line of Hall Street extended, in Beaverton, Oregon, with the northerly line of that tract of land in Section 15, T1S, R1W, W. M. conveyed to Louis and Stephan B. Kahn by deed as recorded at Page 129 of Volume 235 of Washington County, Oregon Deed Records, from which point of beginning the northerly northwest corner of said Kahn tract and the northeast corner of that tract of land conveyed to J. Marvin Wright by deed as recorded at Page 453 of Volume 195 of said Deed Records bears S 88 degrees 34' W 86.8 feet. Thence from the above-described point of beginning N 88 degrees 34' E along the northerly line of said Kahn tract 60.84 feet to the east-

Beginning at the northwest corner of that tract of land in Section 15, T1S, R1E, W. M. conveyed to Florence Graves by deed as recorded at Page 221 of Volume 1 of Washington County, Oregon Deed Records, which beginning point is the intersection of the centerlines of Twelfth and Watson Streets in the City of Beaverton, Oregon; thence S 5 degrees 59' E in the center of said Watson Street and on the Westernly line of said Graves tract 154.3 feet to the easterly line of Hall Street extended; thence N 8 degrees 03' E along the easterly line of said Hall Street extended, 155.9 feet to the northerly line of said Graves tract and the centerline of said Twelfth street; thence S 88 degrees 34' W on the north line of said Graves tract and in the center of
