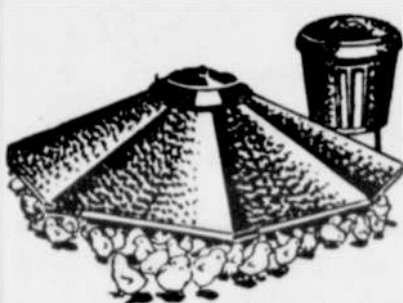

Annual Mission Conference Sets Report Roundup

CEDAR MILL—The Cedar Mill Community Church will share with the Multnomah School of the Bible of Portland, Oregon in an Annual Missionary Conference from February 13-20, reports Rev. Simon E. Forsberg, Minister.

Six missionary societies and as many speakers will be represented during this period. The China Inland Mission and the Scandinavian Alliance Missions will be represented on the opening Sunday, February 13th at the morning and evening services, with Mr. Elden Whipple, N. W. district secretary of Vancouver, B. C. being the morning speaker and Dr. T. J. Bach, general director emeritus, being the evening speaker at the regular services.

Tuesday Night, the 15th, the Central American Mission will be represented by the Rev. William Rice of Nicaragua, Central America. Wednesday Night the 16th, the Canadian Sunday School Mission, will be represented by Rev. Homer B. Edwards, superintendent of the province of Saskatchewan, Canada. Thursday Night, the 17th the Sudan Interior Mission of Africa will present Rev. Howard Borlase of the Anglo-Egyptian Sudan. Friday Night the 18th the Soldiers and Gospel Mission of Chile will present Mr. Clair Moore.

Sunday the closing day of the Conference, February 20th both morning and evening will see Mr. Vincent Joy of the Central Alaska Missions with headquarters at Glenallen, Alaska as speaker. At several of these services special motion, kodachrome, and other pictures will be shown.

Friday, February 11th of this week, the Women's Missionary Society of the Church will present Mrs. Harold V. Good, candidate elect for the Scandinavian Alliance Mission of China.

The Public is cordially invited to share in all these services. The Evening Services are at 8 p.m.

The license fees for licenseable dogs over the age of eight months and for dogs owned and kept within the State of Oregon over 30 days for the year 1949 are: Male Dog \$1.00 Female dog \$1.50 Spayed Female dog \$1.00 After March 1st, 1949, the license fee is \$1.00 more for failure to procure license for the dogs above stated.

Also after March 1st, 1949, the fee is \$1.00 more for failure to procure licenses for licenseable dogs becoming over 8 months of age after March 1, 1949, and for dogs over 8 months old, owned, or kept within the State of Oregon over 30 days after March 1, 1949.

Licenses may be ordered by mail. State the name and address of the person to whom the license is to be issued, and the sex of the dog.
