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Maryhill Shows Popular Western Paintings in Oil

Two exhibits of special interest to westerners are being shown at the present time at Maryhill Museum of Fine Arts, according to an announcement made this week. E. B. Quigley's western paintings, on display until the first of August, strike a very popular theme, and the artist certainly proves his ability to create life-like figures of the cowboys, horses and cattle which make up the more than forty pictures on display.

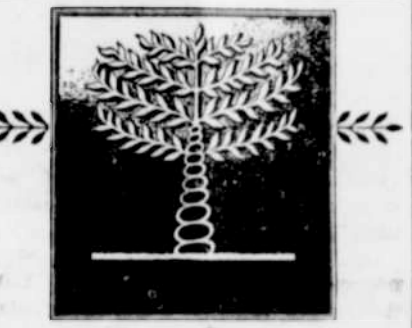
A resident of Portland, Oregon, Quigley spends much of his time each year visiting the large cattle ranches of Eastern Oregon and Washington where he secures the study material for his canvases, all of which portray the everyday ranch life of that region. A thorough knowledge of animal anatomy as shown in his paintings is also evident in the large collection of wood carvings, also included in this one-man exhibition. The popular appeal of Quigley's favorite subject matter—horses and their riders—makes the spectator forget that he is also one of our foremost western artists and a master of competently handled detail and good painting.

The second special exhibit at Maryhill shows the watercolor portraits by F. L. (Fritz) Wertz, Gold Hill artist. All twenty-six paintings are of the leading "Old Timers" of the Gold Hill, Jackson County, district of Oregon. The colorful manner in which the artist has portrayed these "characters" and the neighborhood gossip about them which he has included in the title of each portrait are bringing many chuckles to Museum guests.

The Maryhill Museum of Fine Arts, located in the hilltop mansion of the late Sam Hill, near the junction of Highways 830 and 97, is open every day, including Sundays and holidays, 9:30 to 5:30. Picnic facilities are available.

Please urge your readers that if any magazine solicitors call upon them using the name of Boys Town in any way whatsoever, they should immediately contact their local Better Business Bureau or Police Department so proper investigation may be made and this unauthorized practice may be stopped.

Will you please warn your readers of this magazine racket in which the good name of Boys Town is being misused? We do not want any of our readers to be victimized or taken advantage of by fast-talking magazine salesmen who sell their magazines on the strength of Boys Town rather than on the merits of their publications and mislead people into believing that by subscribing they are contributing to the work which is being done at Boys Town.

Safety Meeting Models Program Western States

A 19-point action program modeled for the 11 Western states has been adopted for the Western region by the board of governors of the Western Safety conference which concluded a three-day safety meet in Portland June 29.

The program is an outgrowth of the recent president's highway safety conference in Washington, D. C. It includes raising of standards of driver license examinations and adoption of uniform vehicle codes.

The plan will have the advantage of a regional approach to safety and accident prevention. It calls for official coordinating committees at state, county and city levels; regional conferences of state and city traffic officials; adoption of approved methods for determining degree of intoxication of drivers; emphasis on school programs and driver training, and "adequate penalties" for all traffic law violators.

The safety conclave was the 11th annual conference of the group and drew participation
