Speaker Blasts Farm Bureau's Reapportionment

Branding the Farm Bureau "bal-
anced" reapportionment proposal
"a scheme to destroy Oregon's
rural voting power and disenfran-
chise 90 per cent of the popula-
tion," Walter H. Dodd of Eugene
discussed reapportionment of the
state legislature before the Wash-
ington County Farmers Union
meeting in Hillsboro Saturday eve-
ning.

Dodd is executive secretary of
the Constitutional Reapportion-
ment Committee which is sponsor-
ing a proposed constitutional
amendment to enforce the consti-
tution which provides for reappor-
tionment of the legislature on the
basis of population.

Washington county would have
the same representation under the
Farm Bureau scheme, Dodd dom-
inated as would Sherman and Gil-
liam counties with a combined
population of 5,000, despite the fact
Washington has more than 60,000
people and 17,500 rural farm
people.

"While increasing Multnomah's
representation, the Farm Bureau,"
Dodd stated, "would actually de-
crease the representation of other
more populous counties." Dodd
pointed out the fact that 87 per
cent of the population of the state,
and 80 per cent of the rural farm
population live in the 18 most popu-
lous counties.

The people in the 18 most popu-
lous counties would forever find
their representation decreased and
limited by the Farm Bureau pro-
vision that each county shall have
at least one representative, Dodd
stated.

Six counties in Oregon, Dodd
commented have less than 5,000
people and all these counties have
been steadily losing population.
"These counties cannot have a full
representative without great in-
justice to the people of the state,"
Dodd urged support for reappor-
tionment on the basis of popula-
tion.

For forty years the legislature
has ignored the mandate of the
constitution which provides for re-
apportionment on the basis of po-
pulation. Under the proposed amend-
ment sponsored by the Constitu-
tional Reapportionment Committee
the power of reapportionment
would be placed in the hands of
the governor, secretary of state
and state treasurer to reapportion
the legislature after each federal
census with a one-third limitation
for the most populous county.

Dodd concluded by contending
that no person has a right to
claim a greater share of the voting
power of the people. "Unequal rep-
resentation in the tax leveling,
policy making bodies leads to the
destruction of free government."
