NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the City Council of the City of Beaverton, Washington County, Oregon, has called a special election to be held on the 7th day of July, 1950, within the corporate limits of the City of Beaverton, at which election there will be submitted to the electors of the City of Beaverton the question of whether the following described contiguous territory shall be annexed to and become a part of the City of Beaverton, Oregon, to-wit:

A tract of land in Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 1 West of W. M., more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Halton A. Stephens by deed recorded in Book 302 page 328 on December 30, 1949, and running thence Westerly along the South line of the Bertha-Beaverton Highway, 834.8 feet to the Northeast corner of that certain tract conveyed to Charles D. Michaelson et ux by deed recorded May 29, 1947, in Book 274 page 609, Deed Records of Washington County, Oregon; thence South along the East line of said Michaelson tract 959.3 feet to the Southeast corner thereof; thence Easterly along the North line of the Thomas H. Denny Claim, 837.4 feet to the Southwest corner of that certain tract conveyed to Halton A. Stephens by deed recorded December 30, 1949 in Book 302 page 328; thence North along the westerly line of said Stephens tract 958.2 feet to the point of beginning.

That said property is being platted and will be known as **SANDBERG'S ADDITION**. The electors shall vote for annexation or against annexation, whichever shall indicate their choice.

The polling place within the City of Beaverton will be at the City Hall, and the poll shall be open from 8:00 a. m. to 8:00 p. m. Standard Time.
