Regulations Cut Clam Limit For Unlicensed Take

With the advent of the summer
season, the Oregon Fish Commis-
sion wishes to remind prospective
clam diggers that the present reg-
ulations governing the digging of
bay clams and razor clams for per-
sonal use are:

1. The taking and/or possession
of clams for personal use means
the taking, digging, or possessing
the clams for one's use individual-
ly or for the use of his family or
guests and not for sale, barter, ex-
change or disposition in any other
manner.

2. Bay clams may be taken for
personal use at any time without
a license in Oregon waters; except
that horse clams may be taken
only during the period July 1 to
December 31 of any year, both
dates inclusive.

3. The bag limit is three dozen
(36) bay clams of all species in the
aggregate in any one day, not
more than eighteen (18) of which
may be horse clams. The first
thirty-six (36) clams dug, taken or
caught shall be counted as and
shall constitute for that day the
personal use bag limit.

4. Razor clams are not included
in the bag limit for bay clams. The
daily bag limit for personal use on
this species also being thirty-six
(36) clams per day. The first
thirty-six (36) razor clams dug or
taken shall be counted as and
shall constitute for that day the
personal use bag limit. Razor
clams may also be taken or dug
at any time for personal use with-
out a license.

Features Crops, Livestock Tours

Two livestock and crops tours
are being planned for 4-H club
members enrolled in those projects
reports county extension agent,
Joe Cox. The tours, to be held
July 31 to August 5, will take one
group into Clackamas and Marion
Counties and the second group into
Columbia County.

Purpose of the events is to give
4-H club members an opportunity
to see some of the best livestock
and crops farms in this part of the
state and to give them an oppor-
tunity to learn to judge all types
of livestock Cox points out.

Those attending the tours will
camp out at night and have an
opportunity for group recreation
each evening.

Although the tours originally
were designed for boys, there will
be an opportunity for girls to par-
ticipate in at least one tour this
year. The Columbia County tour
August 4 and 5 will include girls
as well as boys.

Club members with livestock and
crops projects must make reserva-
tions with Joe Cox, county exten-
sion agent, by July 17.
