Unemployment In County Fades At Start Of Fall

Available labor of Washington county is limited to the number of people contacting the State Employment Service office daily, declared Alvin Elkins, manager of the Hillsboro office.

"We contacted 139 people during the third week of August and 111 were working with only 28 unemployed," he says.

"Total estimated unemployed in Washington county and Vernonia is 175. Of this total 130 are women."

LOGGING: Continues at a high rate. The freight car shortage, combined with low humidity, are the only limiting factors at the present time, with the exception of the labor shortage in skilled help mentioned last month.

SAWMILL AND OTHER WOOD PRODUCTS: The freight car shortage has curtailed some operators dependent upon this means of transportation. These operators are receiving only about 25 to 50 percent of their needs forcing them, where possible, to turn to trucks.

This shortage is expected to continue through October, and it is too early to determine the effect on the industry as a whole. Some operators are only operating four days a week with further curtailment in view, as most operators are not willing to build up their inventory of finished lumber due to the storage problem, and possible price changes.

CONSTRUCTION: Some curtailment in this field was apparent in some areas due to completion of projects, and contract fulfillment. Those men made idle were rapidly absorbed in the area by other contractors. Material shortages are more apparent at this time being led by fabricated materials and plumbing supplies which are the most critical.

Local opinion is that this critical shortage is possibly a small area shortage rather than general, and has been primarily caused by our tremendous amount of construction in the area.

Building permits in Washington county totalled \$191,835 this month. This was a \$25,105 increase over July.

RETAIL AND WHOLESALE TRADE: August reports indicate sales this month are generally 40 to 50 percent over a year ago. This is attributed by most retailers to continued "hysteria buying", and the annual back-to-school parade.

Price increases are generally expected to attempt to get increases effective prior to controls. Some items have been in scarce supply due to strikes in the production field which, in most cases, have been only temporary.

More work stoppages, due to labor troubles, are anticipated although they are very few to date in this area.

CANNING AND PRESERVING: Work in this field is progressing in accordance with crop conditions. The lack of peaches and pears, with curtailed prune crop, is expected to make present season fall below last year's peak of employment. Corn processing is at its peak with broccoli and cauliflower just starting.

AGRICULTURE: Bean harvest is nearly complete. Corn is 75% complete with late hops and prunes next on schedule. Labor is expected to be adequate.

Ever seen the blue and white symbol of the United Nations flying from a staff? You'll probably have a chance to see one—or several—on October 24 this year. That is United Nations day. Spokesmen for a National Citizens' committee for United Nations day, headed by Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, are planning that the public becomes more familiar with the United Nations flag and what it stands for.

Oregon county home economics extension agents and others will take the lead in plans for making and flying United Nations flags in every community October 24, it has been announced by Oregon State college extension officials.

Goal of the move which is nationwide is to make at home at least one United Nations flag for every community, which can be flown or displayed properly when the right occasion arises.

To assist in this national "Betsy Ross" movement, Oregon county extension agents will be supplied soon with kits and patterns to make flags measuring 3 by 5 feet. The kits are being supplied by the National Committee on Boys and Girls 4-H Club work.

The United Nations flag has a blue field with a small outline of the world in the center.

Purpose of the program being sponsored by the National Citizens' committee is three-fold: to encourage a better and more unified understanding by local groups and individuals of the United Nations as an instrument through which free people may jointly express their determination to remain free; to help people to know the United Nations' flag; and to provide a means for women and girls to express in a tangible way their desire to contribute to the United Nations and United States effort for world peace.

Dept. Vet Affairs Eases Payments On Home Loans

Because some veterans with home loans from the State Department of Veterans Affairs may be recalled to service during the present emergency, in some instances working a direct hardship on them, regulations have been set up to take care of this situation, reports Fred B. Corn, County Service Officer.

These are briefly set forth and further information may be secured from the County Service Officer, along with necessary questionnaires.

1. All regulations will apply only where the borrower initiates a request for such consideration, and then only where there is a necessity.

2. Upon entering service a borrower may be granted a three months moratorium if necessary.

3. When moratorium is requested by the borrower in service he will be required to complete the informational questionnaire which will enable the State Department to arrive at a reasonable decision.

4. All income while in service, plus allowances, and his wife's income (if any) will be taken into consideration.

5. In all cases regular payments will commence immediately upon discharge.

6. No payments granted on the reduced basis will be less than the normal interest rate and tax provisions.

7. The property will be inspected annually on the anniversary date of the veterans entry into service to determine the care given the property and to ascertain the borrower's military status.
