Estimated Job Hunters At 140; Outlook Bright

At the Hillsboro office of the state employment service, first of the month, total estimated unemployed numbered 140; of this total 100 are women. With an increase in out-of-state recruitment by large employers this total is expected to drop materially. This recruitment practice should affect local labor supply as some of these job offerings are quite lucrative, even though they involve moving expense.

LOGGING: September production continued high. Shortages still exist in skilled help. The car shortage in some cases has eased slightly, but overall picture remains tight.

SAWMILL AND OTHER WOOD PRODUCTS: A few short shutdowns at some mills did not materially affect total production in the area, due to other limiting factors, mentioned last month, and car shortage being the primary factor. Some shortage still exists in skilled and semi-skilled help.

CONSTRUCTION: This field remained about on a par with August. Material shortages are not more critical than last month. However, most contractors expect further curtailment in the months to come. Building permits in Washington county totalled \$101,314. This marked decrease from August is normal. Residential construction and repair accounted for \$84,360 of this total.

RETAIL AND WHOLESALE TRADE: September reports indicate this field is expected to remain good throughout the rest of the year. Supply, in most cases, is adequate to abundant with only a few retailers mentioning immediate shortages—primarily in the appliance field. Some retailers expect this shortage to become more critical.

CANNING AND PRESERVING: The employment peak in this field has passed. Future work on remaining crops will depend on the weather. The prune harvest is almost complete, with the nut processing ready to start.

AGRICULTURE: The only remaining crops to be harvested are filberts and walnuts. Labor supply is anticipated to be adequate.

Disabled Vets Offer 1st Rate Manpower Skill

Industries expanding to meet defense contracts are reminded by the Veterans Administration of a first-rate source of manpower, ready and willing to train for new skills—the nation's disabled veterans.

Survey after survey have disclosed that these men, when properly placed, prove to be at least as good workers as their able-bodied fellow employees.

In fact, one major study showed that the handicapped suffer fewer serious accidents and build up better production records than do those without physical impairments.

And yet, today—five years after VJ Day—thousands of disabled World War II veterans everywhere in the country still are looking just for an opportunity to prove themselves.

A federally-sponsored program is at their disposal: Public Law 16, the Vocational Rehabilitation Act. But they need a place to train.

Employers who because of increased orders now find themselves in a position to train new workers are urged by the VA to remember America's disabled ex-servicemen.

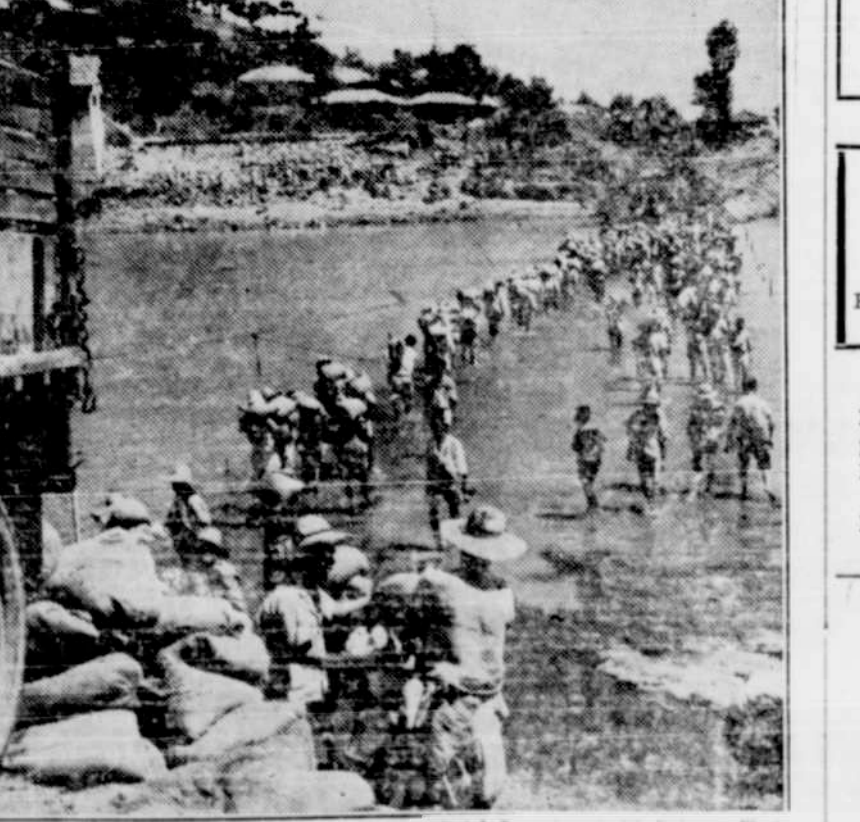
