RESOLUTION NO. 1052

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO IMPROVE SOUTHEAST FIFTH STREET from Tucker Street to Franklin Street.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Beaverton has been petitioned by the property owners being owners of 75% or more of the property abutting the streets to be improved described as follows:

Southeast Fifth Street from the intersection with Tucker Street to the center of the intersection with Franklin Street;

all to a width of 40 feet.

WHEREAS, The said described streets are unimproved and the said improvement will be of direct benefit to the abutting property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BEAVERTON that the City of Beaverton, Washington County, Oregon, proceed to improve Southeast Fifth Street on the following portion thereof, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the

center line of Southeast Fifth Street where the center line of Tucker Street intersects with the said center line of Fifth Street; thence easterly along the centerline of Southeast Fifth Street to a point where the center line of Southeast Fifth Street intersects with the center line of Franklin Street; by regrading and applying a leveling course of rock 24 inches thick, and installation of curbs on both sides of said street, all to the width of 40 feet, being 20 feet on each side of said centerlines, said work to be done by the city street department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost of said improvements be assessed against the abutting property as provided by ordinances and the charter of the City of Beaverton.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that written objections or remonstrances to the said street improvement be filed on or before 8:00 p. m. on October 31st, 1950, at the City Hall in Beaverton, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder is authorized and directed to give notice of this resolution in the time and manner provided by the charter and ordinances of the City of Beaverton and the City Recorder shall serve notice of the intention to make such improvements as required by the ordinances in the manner therein set forth.

Introduced and passed this 16th day of October, 1950.
