Danger Lurks In Mushrooms Use Says Specialist

Eating unfamiliar mushrooms or
toadstool varieties is dangerous,
reminds an Oregon State college
extension plant pathology special-
ist, A. P. Steenland, who adds: if
you don't know them, don't eat
them.

Vast numbers of the fungi are
now appearing in lawns and wood-
lands throughout the state. Al-
though the numbers of poisonous
varieties are comparatively few,
these are deadly poison and not
worth taking the chance to eat,
the specialist adds.

Steenland is now receiving a
large number of fresh specimens
by mail from persons asking to
have them identified. Most of the
specimens when they arrive in
Corvallis, Steenland states, have
been badly shaken up in transit
and it is impossible to make a
positive identification. Rather than
fresh, he suggests sending dried
specimens. The mushroom's base
or ground attachment must also
be included.

Most deadly varieties have a
ring beneath the mushroom cap
and have a cup-like ground attach-
ment, Steenland explains.

The age old test of boiling mush-
rooms in water, then dipping the
handle of a silver spoon into the
pot to see if it will tarnish, thus
indicating presence of poison is
not reliable, he adds.

Winter Driving Brings Dangers Of Death's Call

Cold weather and carbon monox-
ide fumes are often lethal com-
binations on the highways, the
Secretary of State's traffic safety
division warned Oregon motorists
today. Many traffic accidents in
which the driver apparently fell
asleep might be traced to carbon
monoxide poisoning, the division
reminded.

With winter now at hand, motor-
ists were asked to keep a window
slightly open to allow entrance of
fresh air even in coldest weather.
Failure to do so, the division said,
could result in carbon monoxide
poisoning if fumes seep in through
loose floorboards or defective ex-
haust systems.

Last year 254 persons died due
to motor exhaust fumes in the
country.

The gas, which is colorless and
odorless, induces drowsiness even
though the concentration is not
strong enough to be fatal in it-
self, and drowsiness at the wheel
can result in a serious traffic mis-
hap.

The division advised that motor-
ists could avoid winter accidents
by following these safe-driving
tips:

1. Keep windshields and windows
clear of fog or frost.
2. Slow down well in advance
of intersections and curves.
3. Avoid sudden starting and
stopping on slippery surfaces. Ap-
ply brakes with a pumping action
to avoid skidding.
4. Keep far enough behind the
vehicle ahead to allow you to stop
safely if necessary.
