OREGON LIVESTOCK MEN VOTE TO SUPPORT NATIONAL GROUP

Following action taken at a meeting of the State Livestock Auction Association at Redmond on December 11, all of the major Oregon livestock auction markets, beginning January 1, 1951, will initiate deductions on all livestock handled, in support of the nation-wide program conducted by the National Live Stock and Meat Board. This step also has the backing of the Oregon Cattlemen's Association and the Oregon Wool Growers Association.

This support will be rendered through deductions on livestock sold by marketing agencies on the following basis: Cattle 1c per head; hogs and calves 1/2c per head; sheep and lambs 1/5c per head. The meat packing companies contribute on a similar basis.

The National Live Stock and Meat Board was organized by the livestock and meat industry for the purpose of promoting the industry and creating a better market for livestock. The 22 directors who plan its activities represent livestock growers and feeders, livestock marketing agencies, meat packers and retail meat dealers. The work of the Board is conducted in the fields of research, education and promotion.

Organized in 1923, the Board launched a program of research to determine all possible facts concerning the nutritive value of meat. Through this research, which is under way in colleges and universities, meat has been found to be necessary in the diets of infants, children, adults and persons of 50 years and over.

Research has shown meat to be a rich source of the B vitamins, of high quality protein, of the minerals, such as iron and phosphorus, and a good source of energy.

The facts about meat are reaching homemakers, the medical and dental professions, teachers, students and consumers generally through a program of education. This program is featured by lectures and demonstrations, meat cooking schools, meat exhibits, sound motion pictures, literature, and many other activities.

It is pointed out that through the work of the Board meat has become increasingly popular in the nation's diet. During the past 10 years 16 pounds more meat has been consumed per person than in the preceding ten years.

EDITOR'S NOTE:

The place of fresh meat in the daily diet might be even more important, except for the factor of price. To meet this fact, the meat industry has developed a new segment of its production—mainly processed meats from lower grade cuts.

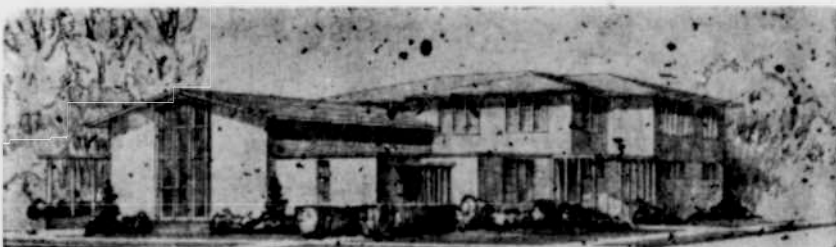

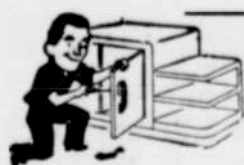
