ALL EUROPE FEELS KINDLY

LOUIS, June 5.—Writing from Paris, Walter Williams, World's Fair representative abroad, says: "There is the kindest feeling toward America just now, and the exposition will reap benefit therefrom. One hears on all sides most cordial expressions of admiration and good will. France will unquestionably make at St. Louis the largest, finest and most attractive exhibit ever made by any European country at a foreign exposition. The receipts of eggs have been rather fair, but when the market becomes slightly clogged they are rushed into cold storage by the newly formed local egg trust. Eggs are quoted today firm at 17 and 17 1/2 cents a dozen.

MINES AND MINING.

L. Y. Cody, O. M. Couch, R. C. Kinney, H. H. McCarthy and A. B. Coustins left Portland yesterday for Grant's Pass and adjacent districts to inspect mining properties. They expect to be absent only four or five days. The LeRoy Company, in the Bohemia district, is driving away without interruption, night and day, on their big tunnel running continuously on one. Their new car and track recently laid is working smoothly.

One of the most important mining developments in Josephine County is the uncovering of immense bodies of copper ore in the Waldo district, about 10 miles westerly from Grant's Pass. Experts give it as their opinion that this is the greatest discovery of copper within the past decade. Colonel Draper, manager, and his business associates have accomplished a large amount of development and with a small smelter erected at the mine have demonstrated the high value of the properties. Over \$100,000 has been expended in development work and mine equipment.

The harvest of gold is now well on in all the placer districts of Southern Oregon. A great quantity of the yellow metal has already been shipped from Grant's Pass to the mint. One thing that will largely swell the output of gold from Southern Oregon this season is the large amount of the precious stuff that is being brought in from the "dry gulch" placers.

The steamer Joseph Kellogg brought in a load of shingles yesterday from Castle Rock and Kelso for shipment to Eastern points.
