

SHILOH, Tenn., June 6.-The Ohlo monuments in the Shiloh Military Pars were dedicated today with impr nies, Governor Nash and staff and prominent men of Ohio taking part in the exercises. Governor Mash and his staff, under military escort, entered the battlefield park mounted. They were received by a large crowd of veteran of Ohio regiments and their friends. Hon. David F. Pugh, of Columbus, was master of ceremonies. Hon. Ralph D. Cole, of Finlay, representing the Ohio Shiloh Battlefield Commission, made a short address, turning over the monu-ments to the state, which was responded to by Governor Nash, who in turn pre-mented the monuments to the National Government. Responses to the address of Governor Nash were made by Colonel Cornelius Cadle, chairman of the National Military Park Commission; Colonel Josiah Patterson of Mamphis, represent-ing the Shiloh Military Park Commission, and Colonel Luke W. Finlay of the Fourth Tennessee, C. S. A., representing the State of Tennessee and the Confeder-ate dead. At the conclusion of the exercises an artillery salute was fired. Today's exercises were but a part of the dedicatory program, additional ceremontes being planned for tomorrow.






