(Continued from page one) will be graduated and the average user will pay less than twenty cents per month at the time of paying his light and water bill. The charge will not be twenty cents a month as has been rumored. By availing themselves of this Federal grant, the citizens of Ashland will be saving an amount nearly equal to the sum they are spending for the sewage facilities. With Medford, Talent, and Grants Pass all installing a sewage disposal plant, it will only be a matter of months before effective pressure will be brought from outside sources under existing laws to compel the construction of more adequate disposal facilities in Ashland.
