Giving Overnight Freight Service

The Southern Pacific Company and Pacific Motor Transport Company are giving wide publicity to the fact that they provide overnight freight service from Portland to this city. An attractive folder outlining the service has just been published and is being distributed to Portland shippers and local merchants. Feature of the broadside is an "animated" map showing that less-than-carload shipments of freight shipped from Portland at night arrive here at 9:15 A. M. the next morning and are given immediate delivery to the door of the consignee.

With the establishment of overnight service to Klamath Falls this week the Southern Pacific and its subsidiary, the Pacific Motor Transport Company, have now extended the service to all major points on its lines in western Oregon. The railroad does the hauling; the pick-up and delivery features are handled by the Pacific Motor Transport Company which employs local transfer companies in the cities where the service is established.

FOSSILS DISCOVERED NEAR CHINA FLATS

CHINA FLATS—What appears to be the fossil remains of some large mastodon's teeth were discovered a few miles above camp on the Coquille River. The teeth are imbedded in solid rock and the enamel is well preserved. They are three inches wide and four or five inches long.

The specimen is being sent to the Oregon State College for classification and will then be returned to the China Flats museum where hundreds of fossils are on display. Bertel Holstrom, one of the most enthusiastic collectors, found the teeth while on one of his regular trips.
