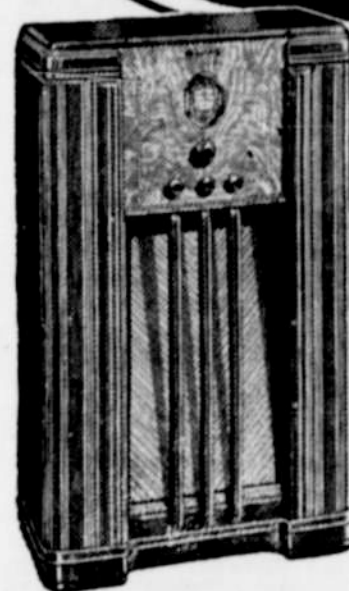
leges object to letting the people know the sources of funds or the expenditure of funds to influence the people.
