County Agent Service Grows

County extension agents have experienced a year of greater activity than ever before measured both by statistics on requests for services and results of work accomplished, according to the annual report recently submitted by F. L. Ballard, vice director in charge of the federal cooperative extension service at Oregon State college.

Recorded calls at the offices of county agricultural agents alone by persons desiring information or assistance of some kind reached a total of 100,001 for the year, an increase of more than 67,000 in the past two years, the reports show. This represents an average of 4,812 calls per county. Meetings held by the county agents total 4,222 or an average of 124 per county, many of these being demonstration meetings where methods and farm processes were shown. In addition to the meetings and calls at the offices, county agents averaged 762 visits to farms and wrote an average of 3,213 letters for the year. No record is made of the thousands of telephone calls received monthly.
