The body was recovered about an hour later at 4:45 o'clock by Rodney Stead who noticed a dark object at the bottom of the pool as he prepared to make a dive.

Resuscitation was unsuccessful and Dr. W. G. Bishop pronounced the boy dead a few minutes after the discovery.
