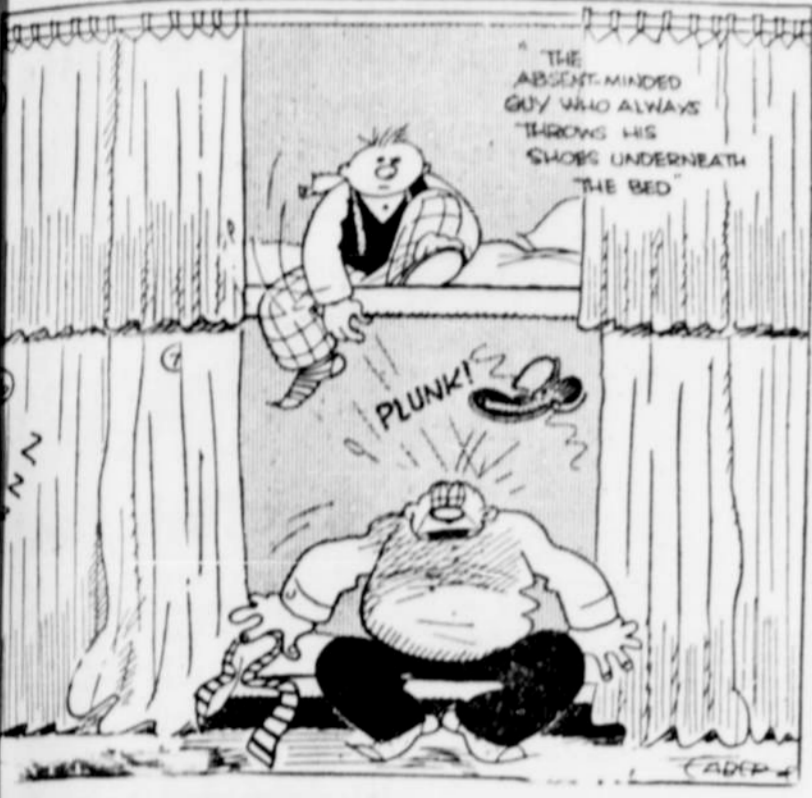

OF ALL THINGS!

EVERY man, woman and child in the US received on the average of three Christmas cards during the last holiday season. For the 10th time, L. K. Sigman, Denver packer, gave away 5000 10-pound parcels of meat to needy families. Over the last 10 Christmases he has given away 250 tons of meat and he says that the first time he did it he had to borrow the money to finance the act.

Hollywood producers save themselves an estimated half million dollars annually by paying expert weather forecaster Dr. Irving Block \$25,000 a year. The doctor has perfected his own system and averages as far as two weeks ahead in 90 per cent accuracy. Airplane lines, truck farmers and citrus growers also use his services and he gives opinions by telephone for \$10.

(He correctly predicted no rain for the Rose Bowl game but some of the SF papers said it was going to be a washout anyway.)

Somebody told us that "the boom pitcher biggies," during 1938, purchased more than 250 stories paying at least \$500,000 each and prices from \$500 to \$50,000 each which, for some reason or other, will never be produced. Anyway judging from some of the films we saw, one or two must have slipped by.

Where do you come in? Domestic commerce survey reports lowest third of population receives up to \$780 per year per person. Middle group income is from \$780 to \$1450 and from there up for highest third with average income for each class \$471, \$1076 and \$300 respectively. Poorer half of the people got 21 per cent of the national income which is only slightly less than top three per cent collected. If you are still reading, the lowest two-thirds got 43 per cent of aggregate income which is about the same as received by upper 10 per cent. Now go on from here alone.
