Oregon enjoyed an employment complexion improvement of five per cent over November, figures covering the December experience of the Oregon state employment service has disclosed. Placements totaled 2715 and 49 per cent were in private jobs.

Medford, covering Jackson and Josephine counties, accounted for 63, or 2.3 per cent of the state SAVE ON GAS AND OIL

Twenty-five per cent of the total were handled through the Portland office. Klamath Falls was next with 11 per cent. Marshfield had 8.2 per cent and Albany and Eugene six per cent each.


