A lot depends tonight on the outcome of the southern Oregon Conference fracas at Klamath when the Grizzlies and the Pelicans clash on Modoc field. Bill Elam, who leads the circuit in touchdowns scored, will be in there fighting for Ashland to the last drop. While Klamath Falls has not been tested against league competition to date, they have topped four highly-rated teams, namely, Chico, Grant high of Portland, Eugene, and Dunsmuir in that order while the Grizzlies have trounced Lakeview, Grants Pass, and Coquille.

But Elam didn't get his present title of the league's leading touchdown-scorer without the aid of one of the finest lines in the SOL. Ashland's line has shown some of the finest offensive and defensive work that has been the pleasure of local spectators to watch in a long while.

The circuit will either be tied two ways with Medford and Klamath sharing top honors after tonight or Ashland will lead with two wins and no defeats. These two undefeated teams are expected to fill Modoc stadium to capacity and a lot of people are planning to sit through the clash with their fingers crossed.
