

How many coowners of a Bond can there be?

A. War Bonds may be issued in the names of only two individuals as coowners, and the reg-istration must be in the alternative, such as "John X. Smith or Mrs. Mary Smith," without any qualifying words or phrases.

If a person who already holds War Savings Bonds up to the limit for the current year should inherit additional Bonds, could they be registered in his name? A. Yes.

Q. How can I be sure that I can get my money back if I buy a War Savings Bond?



The full faith and credit of the United States Government are pledged for payment of both principal and interest. Your Bond is just as sound as the Government itself.

If the owner of a War Sav-ings Bond dies, how is col-lection made?

A. In the absence of a co-owner or beneficiary in the registration, the bond will form a part of the registered own-er's estate, and will be paid to persons entitled to share in the estate under local laws as pro-vided in the regula-
